AMENDED RELIGIOUS EDUCATION GRADUATION AWARDS

St. Thomas the Apostle and St. Patrick's Mission will give scholarship grants to graduating seniors of the Religious Education program, whose family is registered with the parish. The amount of the Religious Education scholarship grant will be determined each year by the Finance Committee of the parish. Three months (three times) collection may be divided among graduating seniors


Rules which govern the scholarship grants are as follows:

1. A student must attend the Religious Education classes for all four years of high school (9-12) and family must be registered with the parish. The scholarship will be prorated if a student attends less than four years. An example would be a student moving into the parish and family registered with the parish in grade twelve (12). That student would only be eligible for $\frac{1}{4}$ of the total scholarship amount.
2. According to the evaluation of the Religious Education teachers, a student must have good class participation and conduct.
3. Students must not have more than five unexcused absences in one year. A prolonged medical condition which may cause an extended number of absences will not count against the student, if a letter from the doctor is presented.
4. If a student withdraws from the Religious Education program at any time, the student loses all rights to any scholarship money.


This is a one-time scholarship grant with the check being made out to the graduating student. As mentioned above, the amount will be determined by the Finance Committee each year.

The Finance Committee of our parish serves as the Arbitration Board.

Checks will not be sent to graduates. If the graduate does not attend the awards ceremony, the checks will be available in the parish office for a period of 15 days.
